P-R-O-C-E-E-D-I-N-G-S

THE COURT: This is State of Wisconsin versus Darrell Brooks, Jr. Case 20CF2550. Appearances.

ATTORNEY CORR: State appears by Jacob Corr. Good morning again, Your Honor.

ATTORNEY DOMASK: Attorney Joseph Domask appears on behalf of Mr. Brooks by zoom video conference. Good morning.

THE COURT: Good morning. We are on the calendar for status/bail hearing this morning. We were last in court on February 9th.

I think Mr. Brooks had entered a speedy trial demand. The state was ready. The defense was ready, but the court was unable to try Mr. Brooks' case because we had another older case that went in front.

The court did reduce bail to \$500. I think my recollection is we set this date to see if Mr. Brooks had been able to post that.

Is that what the lawyers remember?

ATTORNEY DOMASK: Yes.

ATTORNEY CORR: Yes.

THE COURT: Okay. And I don't see that he has. Is that correct?

1                   ATTORNEY DOMASK: Judge, can you  
2 check with your deputies whether or not that's been  
3 posted? I don't see it reflected on CCAP.

4                   However, I had a phone call from his  
5 son, his adult son, earlier this week saying that  
6 the money was to be posted or was posted but that  
7 there was some sort of child support issue in  
8 Waukesha and he may have been transferred to  
9 Waukesha County Jail. I can't confirm that. I  
10 don't see it on CCAP.

11                  THE COURT: And I don't see it  
12 posted. But there was a hold with Waukesha.

13                  Can we check to see what Mr. Brooks'  
14 status is?

15                  THE BAILIFF: Checking right now.

16                  THE COURT: Thank you very much.

17                  THE BAILIFF: It says he was out on  
18 bail on this charge. He has a Waukesha detainer.

19                  THE COURT: My deputy is telling me  
20 that their system shows him out on bail on this  
21 charge and he did have the Waukesha hold.

22                  My suggestion is that we set  
23 another status date just to I guess make sure that  
24 he's out and that -- Because we have a June 28th  
25 trial date.

1                   ATTORNEY CORR: Well, Judge, why  
2                   don't we -- If your deputy says he's out, we don't  
3                   have any control over Waukesha. Why don't we just  
4                   set a status date a week before the June 28th date  
5                   in order to -- If Joe needs another date before  
6                   that time if something happens, we can always bring  
7                   it in.

8                   THE COURT: That makes sense if  
9                   that's okay with you, Mr. Domask.

10                  ATTORNEY DOMASK: That's fine with  
11                  me. I don't have any more information about the  
12                  hold in Waukesha other than what I just told you.  
13                  So I'm hopeful to get a little more information on  
14                  it in the next week or two.

15                  THE COURT: All right. We'll give  
16                  you a status date sometime in June so that we can  
17                  make sure we're still on track for trial.

18                  If there's some other issue, you can  
19                  let me know and we can always hear this earlier if  
20                  we need to.

21                  ATTORNEY DOMASK: Okay.

22                  ATTORNEY CORR: Judge, do you want  
23                  to do it on the 21st since we just set that date  
24                  for McNeil since Joe and I will both be there?

25                  THE COURT: That will be fine.
